

Q & A for Perry Camp & After School Program RFP Updated 5/13/22

1. Do we have to provide services for all youth ages 6-18?

No. programs can target specific ages and or age ranges.

2. Are vendors solely responsible for finding participants, or will they work in combination with PCJFS?

Vendors are responsible for finding participants. However, HAPCAP will support the vendor with strategies and provide additional social media and other outreach to promote the program.

3. Is there a minimum length of time required for programs?

No.

4. At what length of a program does the requirement for providing lunch begin?

As noted in the Program Standards, lunch should be provided if the program is all day long. To clarify, if the program is operating during lunch hours lunch should be provided. If you are not sure how you will meet this requirement, please indicate in your RFP response what efforts you made.

5. How Many In School Youth does PCJFS Serve yearly?

Both HAPCAP and PCJFS have a variety of programs that serve school aged youth and their families. Specific to this program, 54 youth were served in 2021.

6. What is the process of Program Enrollment?

The program enrollment will be determined by the vendor and approved by HAPCAP. In terms of TANF Eligibility, a one page self attestation application will have to be completed by the family and submitted to HAPCAP for review and then HAPCAP will provide to PCJFS for final approval determination.
