The Quality Jobs, Equality, Strategy, and Training (QUEST) Disaster Recover Dislocated Workers Grant (DWG) is a federal grant aimed at helping individuals whose employment has been impacted by COVID-19, layoffs, or other factors to reenter the workforce into the Broadband sector by providing funding, for those who qualify, for Fiber Optic Technician and 5G Tower Technician training programs.
